

## DemiCon Room Party Guidelines

These are basic guidelines for responsible party hosting. Room Parties at DemiCon are considered a “Private” function, not Convention sanctioned or sponsored. As the host of a room party at DemiCon you have a few responsibilities to our members and staff.

1. All room parties will be held on the 5<sup>th</sup> floor. Any party found outside the designated party floor, will be asked to shut down.
2. Rangers and Security will be patrolling the party floor.
3. If you choose to serve alcohol, it is not necessary to bring a fully stocked bar. Generally having one or two options for “Alcoholic” beverages and a selection of Non alcoholic beverages plus assorted snacks and munchies is sufficient.
4. If you choose to serve alcohol, please check the ID of any guest requesting it. It is your responsibility to observe Iowa law which states an individual must be 21 years of age to consume alcoholic beverages. That means they must be born before 4/29/1990.
5. As the host, monitor your own alcohol consumption as well as that of your guests. Please stop serving someone if you believe they have had too much drink. If the person in question creates a problem because of this, call for assistance from Security. They may be on patrol nearby. Or contact the Consuite on 5<sup>th</sup> Floor and ask for Security
6. **Badges with clipped corners** mean the individual has been deemed by Convention Staff to have consumed more than sufficient quantity of alcohol for that evening.
